NOTICE OF RESCISSION OF A LAND APPLICATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR DISCHARGING TREATED WASTEWATER ONTO A LAND APPLICATION SYSTEM AND THEN INTO WATERS OF THE STATE.

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is considering the rescission of a Land Application System (LAS) Permit for the following applicant, subject to specific pollutant limitations and special conditions:

Brunswick – Glynn County Joint Water & Sewer Commission, 700 Gloucester Street, Suite 300, Brunswick, Georgia 31520, LAS Permit No. GA02-059, for its Glynn County – I-95/US 17 LAS located on U.S. Highway 17 and I-95 in Brunswick. This facility has been replaced by the Exit 29 Water Pollution Control Plant.

Persons wishing to comment on the proposed permit rescission are invited to submit their comments in writing to the EPD address below, within 30 days of this notice. All comments received before or on that date will be considered in the formulation of final determinations for this permit. "Brunswick – Glynn County Joint Water & Sewer Commission (Glynn County)" should be placed at the top of the first page of comments. A public hearing may be held where the EPD Director finds a significant degree of public interest for the proposed permit rescission. Additional information regarding public hearing procedures is available by writing the EPD.

The permit is available for review at 4220 International Parkway, Suite 101, Atlanta, Georgia 30354, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday and at Brunswick – Glynn County Joint Water & Sewer Commission during normal business hours.
