THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE FOLLOWING CHANGES OR CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Invitation to Bid - Section 5. Determination of Successful Bidder, Item 6; Requirement Removal/Change

The JWSC wishes to remove the requirement for a qualified bidder to have a **Georgia** Utility Contractor License for Pumpstation 2032 Regional Forcemain Improvements – Project No. 505. State utility contractor licensure is still required. Bidder is instructed to submit proof of similar licensure from another state in place of the Georgia Utility Contractor license requirement.

2. Prequalification Application – Attachment No. 2 – Contractor's Qualification Statement, Item 3(a) State of Georgia Utility Contractor License Number; Requirement Removal/Change

The JWSC wishes to change the requirement in this section for a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License number to allow for acceptance of alternate state's utility contractor licensure if no current State of Georgia license is held by said firm. Firms submitting pre-qualification application under this condition are instructed to submit both license number and State of Origin if their utility contractor license is not issued from the State of Georgia.



3. **Pre-Qualification Application Instructions**

The Contractor's Qualification Statement shall be filled out in full by typing or legible hand lettering in ink. All pages may be copied as needed. An original and one copy of the Prequalification Application package must be submitted no later than **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 9, 2016** to: Ms. Pamela Drury-Crosby, Director Procurement Division Brunswick-Glynn County Joint Water and Sewer Commission Administrative Services Building 1703 Gloucester Street Brunswick, Georgia 31520. Electronic submissions will be accepted via email, pcrosby@bgjwsc.org but must be submitted in one (1) combined file.

The prequalification of a Contractor will not deprive the Brunswick-Glynn County Joint Water and Sewer Commission of the right to reject any bid, where other circumstances and developments have, in the opinion of the JWSC, changed the qualification or responsibility of the Contractor. This is not a solicitation for bid. No guarantees are made or implied that a project will be constructed, either in part or whole.
