****These questions were submitted by the question deadline and were overlooked in error by
BGJWSC Procurement****

- 1) Section 2.2 of page 2 of 16 is incomplete as it only states: “In addition, there shall be two (2) optional twelve (12) month terms that may be”**
 - o The 2 additional terms may or may not be exercised depending on BGJWSC needs**

- 2) Section 2.4 of page 1 of 13 seems to be incomplete: “...from taxation of the interest paid on the Refunding Bonds, and documentation a (a) Tax Regulatory Agreement , and (b) Post Issuance Tax Compliance procedures, if required.”**
 - o “Provide the BGJWSC with advice on compliance with Federal tax rules related to maintaining an exemption”**

- 3) Regarding insurance requirements, Bryant Miller Olive P.A does not have any company cars. Are we still required to carry automobile bodily injury liability?**
- **No, but please be aware that we are not responsible for any travel related injuries or liabilities that may occur.**
- 4) Under the Methodology and Approach section you request a proposed Action Plan. Please explain how this differs from the methodology.**
- **The two are interconnected. The Action Plan refers to what your methodology/approach would be with some specific outlines and timeframes of activity. For example, if we are looking at a 3/1 closing date for the bond transaction, what would be the major milestones and timelines in achieving this.**
