



# Brunswick-Glynn County Joint Water and Sewer Commission

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### Approved and Effective February 1, 2018

Capital Improvement Fees are intended to cover the cost of water production and distribution and waste water collection and treatment infrastructure. The capital tap fee shall be calculated and charged on the basis of water meter size. Capital improvement fees may be used by the Utility to pay for debt incurred to fund this type of infrastructure.
