THIS ADDENDUM IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ANSWERING THE FOLLOWING **QUESTIONS:**

1) QUESTION: Page One (1) of the RFP requires the submission of a Price Proposal. Page Two (2) states that the document is a Qualifications based procurement of Professional Engineering services. Is JWSC requiring pricing?

ANSWER: Yes, JWSC has made the decision to include price as a factor in the evaluation of this RFP

2) QUESTION: We understand that there was an Odor Control Study conducted at the WPCF in Summer/Fall of 2018. Would the JWSC make this study available?

ANSWER: Yes, a trial was completed utilizing a magnesium hydroxide-lime slurry addition at three (3) upstream pump stations. The data from this trial will be made available to the selected firm.

3) QUESTION: Will there be a pre-proposal meeting required for this project?

ANSWER: No, a pre-proposal meeting has not been scheduled for this solicitation. Any questions regarding this RFP may be presented to Pamela Crosby, BGJWSC Director of Procurement, via email (pcrosby@bgjwsc.org), no later than 5:00PM March 15, 2019.

4) QUESTION: Are there any odor control measures currently being implemented at Academy Creek, and if so what are the types and locations of the measures being employed?

ANSWER: There is currently a chemical mist being sprayed around the influent wet well that assists with odor masking
