1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Brunswick-Glynn Joint Water & Sewer Commission (JWSC) wishes to receive bids for forcemain improvements in the Oak Grove Road area of Brunswick, Glynn County, GA, 31525, within the North Mainland service district.

The scope of work for this work includes furnishing all skill, labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals required to construct complete, in place, and ready to operate a new 10-inch forcemain along a portion of Oak Grove Road in Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia including but not limited to tree removal; erosion and sedimentation controls; installation of forcemain by horizontal directional drilling and open cut construction; connection of forcemain to existing JWSC 10" FM; all Maintenance of Traffic including temporary pathway; all restoration work; and all other work and appurtenances required, the lump sum amount of. This work and bid includes: Driveway cuts and replacement in-kind per the approved plans at the time of bid, coordination for all driveway work, asphalt cutting, demolition, and replacement as shown in the plans.

Two alternates will be also be considered for this bid:

For furnishing all skill, labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals required to construct complete, in place, and ready to operate a new 4-inch forcemain along a portion of Oak Grove Road in Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia including but not limited to tree removal; erosion and sedimentation controls; installation of forcemain by horizontal directional drilling and open cut construction; connection of forcemain to existing JWSC 10" FM; all Maintenance of Traffic including temporary pathway; all restoration work; and all other work and appurtenances required, the lump sum amount of. This work and bid includes: Driveway cuts and replacement in-kind per the approved plans at the time of bid, coordination for all driveway work, asphalt cutting, demolition, and replacement as shown in the approved plans at the time of bidding.

For furnishing all skill, labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals required to construct complete, in place, and ready to operate a new 6-inch forcemain along a portion of Oak Grove Road in Brunswick, Glynn County, Georgia including but not limited to tree removal; erosion and sedimentation controls; installation of forcemain by horizontal directional drilling and open cut construction; connection of forcemain to existing JWSC 10" FM; all Maintenance of Traffic including temporary pathway; all restoration work; and all other work and appurtenances required, the lump sum amount of. This work and bid includes: Driveway cuts and replacement in-kind per the approved plans at the time of bid, coordination for all driveway work, asphalt cutting, demolition, and replacement as shown in the plans.

Bidders are encouraged to check the website throughout the solicitation process as all updates will be posted there via addenda. Bidders shall thoroughly review all documentation associated with the solicitation prior to submitting a bid.

A mandatory pre-bid teleconference will be held on Tuesday, September 21, 2021, at 2:00 p.m. EST. The purpose of this teleconference is to present and clarify information about the Project and procurement process and respond to any immediate questions that Bidders may have about this bid. Pre-registration for this event is required. Please email pcrosby@bgjwsc.org no later than Monday, September 20, 2021, at 12:00 NOON to confirm your planned attendance. Failure to attend the mandatory pre-bid teleconference shall result in the Bidder being disqualified from submitting a Bid on this project.

The firms must comply with all applicable state, local and federal regulations related to the services provided to the BGJWSC. The BGJWSC reserves the right, subject to negotiation and agreement, in writing, with the selected firm, to either expand or limit the scope of services as needed. The selected firm will be required to have sufficient personnel to complete the tasks required by this scope of services. The selected firm will complete the required tasks in a timely and efficient manner. The selected firm would be expected to enter into a contract for services based upon the firm's hourly rates and an agreed-upon not to exceed amount.

All services performed shall be in accordance with applicable BGJWSC Standards. Firms expressing interest should be fully capable of providing the end results requested.

All bids must be made on the Bid Form included with the Contract Documents for the proposed work. No Bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening thereof. All bids shall remain valid for that period of time.

The award (if an award is made) will be made as provided in the bid. The award shall be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided that if the JWSC believes that the public interest will be best served by accepting other than the lowest bid, it shall have the authority to accept the bid that will best serve the public interest. The JWSC reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, alternate bids, or unit prices and/or waive any irregularities in any bid received.

Time of Completion shall be (180) calendar days after issuance of the Notice to Proceed date. Liquidated damages of one-thousand dollars (\$1,000) per day for failure to complete the work within the specified time are specified in the Contract Documents. The Contractor will be required to comply with all applicable Equal Employment Opportunity laws and regulations. All bids must cover the entire work required under this contract.

Bidders' attention is directed to the Special Provisions of the Contract Documents which require the Contractor, to whom the contract for the work is awarded, to meet all requirements of said Contract Documents and approved by the JWSC Attorney.

Additionally, all forms relevant to Insurance, Drug-Free Workplace, EEO and E-verify are to be executed at this time.

2.0 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The selected firm shall be responsible for obtaining any additional information needed for their evaluation and completion of work. Additional evaluation activities will be the responsibility of the selected firm. Any costs involved with additional information are the responsibility of the selected firm.

The Contractor is to complete all work within <u>180 days</u> of a signed Notice to Proceed date that will be established at the pre-construction meeting. The JWSC requires that selected firm be available for weekly progress meetings (either onsite at JWSC or via teleconference) with all noted deliverables. Each firm is to submit Section 6.0 Project reference forms for projects of similar scope and size. Each firm's experience and qualifications will be evaluated primarily as they relate to the firm's ability to provide the specific services requested by the JWSC in this solicitation.

The BGJWSC will make an award only to a responsible firm possessing the ability to perform successfully under the terms and conditions of the procurement. The intent is to award to the lowest bidder and consideration will be given to such matters as firm integrity, compliance with public policy, record of past performance, and financial and technical resources. The BGJWSC has exclusive and sole discretion to determine the firm whose services will be most advantageous to the BGJWSC and reserves the right to reject all firms. A number of firms may be asked to express their interest in regard to these services in the form of a bid. Following the receipt of Bids, a certain firm or firms may be selected for further consideration.

Any verbal statements regarding same by any person prior to the award shall be considered not authoritative and not binding. The deadline for questions is 5:00 p.m. EST on Friday, September 24, 2021.

Addenda issued to Bidders prior to the date of receipt of bids shall become a part of the bid and Bid Submission Package shall include the work described in the Addenda. No inquiry received within five days of the date fixed for the submission of bids will be given consideration.
