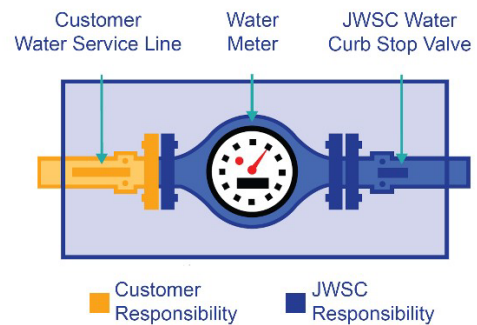
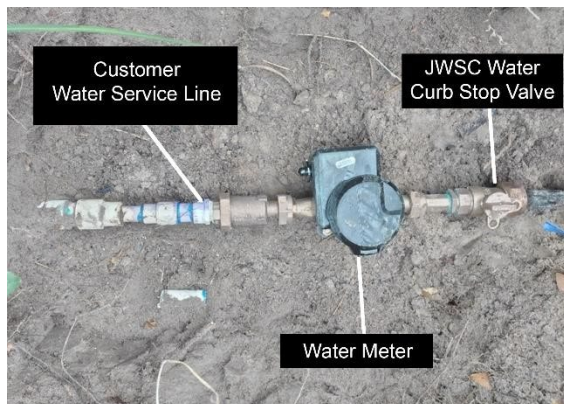

HOW TO IDENTIFY YOUR WATER SERVICE MATERIAL:



LSL IDENTIFICATION GUIDE

1. Find your water meter.
2. Locate the water service line as it enters into the building from the water meter. The service line is typically between 12-24 inches below ground level.
3. Identify a "test area" on the pipe between the point where it leaves the meter box and meets your home. Expose a small area of the pipe if it is covered or wrapped.
4. Have a screwdriver and magnet handy. Use the flat edge of a screwdriver to scratch the pipe gently. Remove any corrosion that may have built up on the outside of the pipe.

MATERIAL I HAVE IDENTIFIED

Lead: Use a strong magnet; it will not cling to a lead pipe. A dull, silver-gray color that is easily scratched with a coin.



Galvanized: The scratched area will be silver-gray, and the pipe will have threads on each end; Use a magnet - strong magnets will typically stick to galvanized pipes; Galvanized pipes are old, corroded iron pipes.



Copper: The scratched area will have the color of a copper penny. A strong magnet will not cling to a copper pipe.



Plastic: A strong magnet will not cling to a PVC pipe and is dull in color.
